STATEMENT OF POLICY ON HEALTH & SAFETY

DANCE CONNECTION SCHOOL OF DANCE has a responsibility to ensure the Health & Safety of all its employees, volunteers and helpers while at work. Dance Connection School of Dance will provide, as far as is reasonably practicable, a working environment that is safe and with minimum risk to employees, volunteers, students, visitors and members of the public. This will be achieved by:

Seeking at all times to provide safe working procedures, good working conditions and a health working environment.

Ensuring that all employees and volunteers know of the potential hazards associated with the various activities undertaken by Dance Connection School of Dance and are aware of how to avoid associated risks.

Providing training and instruction to enable employees and volunteers to perform their work safely and efficiently.

Promoting the maximum individual attention and effort on behalf of employees and volunteers at all levels to avoid and prevent accidents.

While the overall responsibility for Health & Safety rests with the Principal, all employees and volunteers at every level have a duty to fulfil their legal obligations and responsibilities.

Dance Connection School of Dance is required to undertake a statutory Risk Assessments of all work place Health & Safety risks. The significant findings of these statutory Risk Assessments are communicated to all those at risk.
